Information You Need to Know

Welcome to Pineville!
We hope that you will

Pineville is a great community in a large metropolitan area, but we work hard to maintain the small town feel.

To do that, we have in place ordinances and policies to assure all of our citizens enjoy a high quality of life.

These ordinances are designed to protect and enhance our neighborhoods, making Pineville a great place to live and adding value to our homes.

Here is some helpful information to help you know more about the Town of Pineville.



Trash Collection

We do our trash collection every Monday (except on Holiday Schedule) for household trash, recycling, and yard waste. We ask that your roll-out container and recycling bin is placed on the curb no sooner than the night before, and returned by Monday evening. Any large items can be picked-up by appointment, scheduled through Town Hall.

Yard Maintenance

The Town's ordinance requires all yards to be maintained to insure safety and high standards of community appearance. A yard is considered in violation if it has grass or weeds in excess of 12 inches in height. This covers all areas of the property; front, side, and rear yards. It is also illegal to blow leaves or grass clippings into the street or storm water drains. Violation of this ordinance can result in fines and related actions.

Junk Vehicles

Junk vehicles can be a major attraction to unwarranted pests; a cause of environmental problems; and visible eyesores. Any vehicle considered to meet the definition of "junk" must be removed from the property. One vehicle, located in the rear yard and completely covered is allowed. Any other vehicles or any vehicles not meeting the requirements are subject to fines and towing.

Parking in the Front Yard

Parking a vehicle in the front yard of any residential use is prohibited unless in the driveway or other designated area meeting the requirements set forth in the Town Code. Any area designated for parking must be an improved driveway or parking pad and cannot use more than 25% of the designated front yard.

Community Appearance

The Town Zoning Ordinance has several provisions that require general maintenance of property to protect the general health, safety, and welfare of the residents. The Community Appearance Ordinance addresses issues of trash, construction debris and materials, and other clutter from being visible from the street. It is the responsibility of the owner and the tenant to keep the property clean and trash free.

Other Concerns

As with all communities, Pineville has ordinances that deal with noise, odor, leash laws, clean-up of animal droppings, and other similar concerns. These and all other ordinances can be found at Town Hall.
